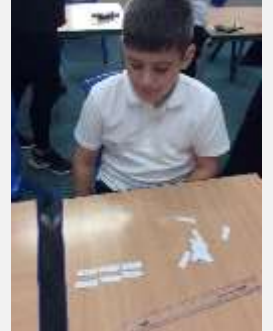

## Maths

We have covered the topics of Place Value, Decimals, Written Addition and Subtraction, Angles, Perimeter and Time.



## English

In English we have looked at Legends, focussing on legends in the U.K. We studied the legend of Robin Hood and debated the merits of stealing from the rich to give to the poor. We also looked at Persuasive writing and linked English with our Geography topic of the U.K, creating a power point presentation to persuade holiday makers to visit our UK country of choice. We then ended the term with a revision of sentence construction, looking at the use of verbs, adverbs, modal verbs, clauses and parenthesis.

### Science
