Summer 1 term



Maths

This half term in maths we have been learning all about various skills such as; measuring angles, mixed numbers, mixed numbers on a number line, dividing with remainders, calculating the perimeter of regular polygons and counting fractions as a whole. Although we have covered a lot of skills this half term the children have shown amazing resilience in powering through and gaining new skills or learning a new skill.



English

This half term we have been looking in depth at the rain forest. We have spoken about the animals that live there, the tribes that reside in the rain forest and how they survive, the plants and trees that grow there and also the long river that runs through the heart of the rain forest. After gaining a lot of knowledge about this fantastic place the children were asked to write a story which would have the main setting as the Amazon Rain Forest. They all produced some brilliant stories. We have also taken part in class debates with the motions revolving around de-forestation and how it affects the people and animals that live there and the world in general.

Science

This half term in Science we have been looking at the human life cycle and the various stages throughout a human's life. The Legends 1&2 have shown a great level of maturity throughout this half term whilst discussing these subjects. They have also shown good understanding of how the human life cycle works, the changes that we all go through at various stages of our life and how these changes may affect us a person. We have had group discussions about some of the changes that can happen to our bodies at certain stages of our lives and the children can confidently remember the 5 key stages of the human life cycle.





Computing

This half term we have been looking at using computers and Ipad's to record data such as; the UV rays, sound in a room and temperature. Once all the data had been recorded we then used our graph reading knowledge to answer questions about the data we have collected.



Spanish

This half term in Spanish we have been looking at the Spanish words for various foods and short sentences that could be used when visiting a restaurant.



PHSE

In our PSHE lessons we have been looking at mental health in children and young people. The children have really enjoyed this topic and had real input into the lessons. We have also been looking at the meaning and the effects of grief.

Forest School

This half term we have been looking at Anglo-Saxon history and how they used the forest to help them build their houses, make tools, provide protection and provide food. After learning about this we had a go at making a small-scale Anglo-Saxon hut with materials from our very own forest.



Art

This half term in our art sessions we have been looking at a very famous painter, Wassily Kandinsky. We learnt that this man had a condition called synaesthesia, this means that when he heard music he could see colours and shapes in which he relayed these images on to a canvas. These paintings have become very famous and have sold for a lot of money. This most expensive one selling for £45million. With the thought of money in mind the Legends children had a go at recreating art in his style.
