Updates:

- There were at least 2 class entries for the I am Special (Pride) competition

- Yoga mats are free for children to use for class yoga however they will need to be wiped down after use, looked after and stored properly if in the cabins area
- Feedback from classes: School library and reading place well received, children are keen for a gardening club and want to do game trades with other classes (2-3 games swapped)
- Mrs Pennington has emailed some class leads to try arrange a small trip to tesco/B&M to buy frisbees

AOB

- KW said his class would like more footballs, swings in the playground and astroturf on the MUGA.
 Miss Sharp explained astroturf on the MUGA would mean no go kart track and would probably be very expensive. Mrs Pennington will ask Mr Standring about footballs
- MC said that she wanted the swimming pool here all year round. Mrs Pennington and Miss Sharp explained it would be tricky to facilitate swimming lessons outdoors in the winter
- LSP said that her class would like the playground updating and the Go Karts fixing. Mrs Pennington will check with Mr Henderson about when equipment will be fixed
- AY asked if we could have pets at school. Mrs Pennington said that we currently don't have anywhere to house pets at school and there would be issues with caring for the animals over holidays and half terms
- BH said his class would like a cosplay day or at least another non-uniform day before the end of the school year. Mrs Pennington to ask SLT
- BH said that school should arrange a whole school waterpark trip Miss Sharp explained not everyone can swim but that BH should ask his class teacher about his upcoming class trips

- LN suggested that the climbing frame in the MUGA should be replaced with a drop slide
- LN suggested that a running hamster wheel should also feature on the playground to help with running safely
- LSP suggested a fruit and vegetable day. It was discussed that school do provide healthy snacks for the children every day and LSP said "maybe we can learn about how to be healthy"

The children were all thanked for bringing their imaginative ideas and praised for their creativity.

- Mrs Pennington to arrange buying frisbees with children next week
