

Superheroes Summer 2024

Superheroes have continued to build on their fantastic start to the year and we are very proud of the progress our Superheroes are making. There are still eight Superheroes supported by five staff and the children have built lovely relationships with all of the adults who support them.

Communication and Language/Literacy

We have continued to develop our early literacy skills through 1:1 reading, rhyme time and mark making opportunities. The children enjoy exploring a range of media to mark make including stamps, sand, chalk and paint. We continue to use 'Singing Hands' to support our Makaton and communication skills with familiar rhymes such as 'Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star' and 'Aunt Polly had a Dolly' alongside new songs linked to our topics such as 'Five Little Firemen'.



Maths

In Maths, we have covered a range of topics including number, shapes and measurement. We have enjoyed sorting shapes and discovering patterns in the world around us particularly the chance to incorporate Maths through a thematic and topical approach to link with our communication and language.



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Physical Development and Forest

We have focused on fundamental ball skills in addition to the transition from our classroom to the main hall for some lessons. The children have been developing their ball skills including catching and throwing. In the Forest, the children have been exploring the natural world whilst developing resilience and independence skills.



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Understanding the World/Expressive Arts and Design

Since our last report, we have enjoyed two new topics of 'Life on the Farm' and 'People Who Help Us' which we have all enjoyed immensely! Each of our little Superheroes continue to make fantastic progress and each day brings a new small step on their learning journey. The children have also had the opportunity to take part in 'World of Work' weeks where we had visits from Police Officers, Firefighters, Farmers and many more!
