

### **English/Communication and Language**

This half term, we will be continuing to build on our existing communication skills through rhymes, Makaton, widge symbols and PECS where appropriate. We will continue to use 'Singing Hands' as inspiration for songs and rhymes to develop our listening and joint attention skills. We will be enjoying books and stories from around the world, both fiction and non-fiction and we will be using these stories as a basis for our sensory exploration.

We will continue to develop a range of mathematical concepts in our continuous provision.

### **Outdoor Learning**

This half term, the children will have the opportunity to explore the outdoor area including the forest including sensory walks and nature exploration. We will use the outdoor areas as a stimulus for sensory activities linked to the different continents we are learning about as well as enjoying weekly forest session with Miss Weldon.

### **PSED**

We will be focusing on self-care and developing the children's independence particularly building on transitioning around school and working with peers.

### **PE & Physical Development**

Our theme this half term is Music and Movement. We will focus on different movement skills to music as well as the children having the opportunity to try swimming in the last few weeks of term.
