Geography

We will be learning about our locality beyond the school gate. The children will explore the local area using first hand observation to enhance their locational awareness along with developing essential map and fieldwork skills.

Other Curriculum Areas

Computing

Within Computing we will be focussing on Computer Science using Scratch and Turtle Logo. We will be learning to create an algorithm to move or rotate the Turtle and learning how to use the repeat command. We will be looking at how to debug and algorithm and how we will know if an algorithm has worked.

RE

We will learn about how nature can be important across religions and we will make links between religions. The children will learn the Christian Creation story, about the importance of harvest to some Christians and Jews by learning about harvest festivals and Sukkot. We will then go on to hear stories from Buddhism and Islam which highlight the importance of looking after nature and we'll think about how the messages in these stories can help us in our everyday lives.

Design Technology

We will be making models out of recycled materials, linked to our Science topic.

Music

Music has a pulse, a steady beat. Music is also made up of long and short and high and low sounds, called 'rhythm' and 'pitch'. As we listen to, sing, play and dance to the music, we will explore these elements of music and how they work together.
