Mathematics

We will be learning about how to solve addition and subtraction problems as well as multiplication and division problems using a variety of different methods.

Science

This half term our topic is 'Animals – Survival & growth'.

We will be learning that animals, including humans, have offspring that grow into adults. We will learn that basic needs all animals need to grow healthily.

Each week we will learn about a different type of animal; mammals, birds, fish, amphibians, reptiles and humans.

PE & Physical Activity

'Target Games' is our unit focussing on throwing, rolling, kicking and batting. We will learn about body positioning and how to aim for objects that are moving and that are stationary.

PSHRE

We will be focussing on 'Celebrating Differences.' This will include identifying what makes ourselves and other people unique and that it is important to respect other people's beliefs and differences. We will learn about families and their differences, family conflict and how to manage it (child-centred) and identify how to solve incidents of bullying. We will learn to recognise how words can be hurtful and give and receive compliments.

The Incredibles



History

This half term our topic is 'Explorers – significant others.'

The children will explore why some people are considered to be significant before going on to learn about some significant explorers. By the end of term children should know who Christopher Columbus, James Cook and Neil Armstrong all were and what they were known for.

Other Curriculum Areas

Computing

Within Computing we will be focussing on Electronic Communication. We will be learning about how we can share information online, how emails work and find out if all emails are good. We will learn about how we can communicate online whilst keeping ourselves safe.

RE

This half term our topic will be 'Light and Dark'. We will learn about the importance of light to many in Christianity, Hinduism and Judaism through learning about Advent, Christmas, Diwali and Hanukkah. Children learn how and why light can be important to each festival through participating in lots of practical and creative activities. We will learn about what light and darkness can represent and symbolise in each religion. Towards the end of the unit children will begin to make simple links and comparisons between the different religions.

Music

All of our Music learning is focused around one song: 'Ho Ho Ho' - a Christmas song. We will listen and appraise other styles of music and continue to embed the interrelated dimensions of music through games, singing and playing instruments.

Outdoor Learning inc. Forest School & Visits

Weekly forest school sessions will link and embed all curriculum learning.

Our Forest sessions will include potion making, making diwa lamps, making houses linked to the 'Three Little Pigs' books and making puppets.

We will take our learning outdoors each week to embed the curriculum in different environments.
