#### Introduction

In our summer term, Titans class are continuing to go from strength to strength, developing new skills and progressing with their speech and communication skills. This term we have had lots of fun looking at 'Our environment', continuing to learn through a semi-formal curriculum.

#### English (Communication skills)

In our English sessions we have looked into; traditional tales, stories with familiar settings, non-fiction texts, jobs, traditional rhymes. When exploring traditional tales, the children did a fantastic job at listening to the famous stories, exploring through different avenues, such as sensory play, fine motor activities, sequencing and ordering and many more! Additionally, our higher ability children planned and wrote their own story when identifying stories with familiar settings, focusing on the use of capital letters and full stops. ## Maths (Thinking skills)

In maths, the children have explored place value, position and direction, mass and volume, with our higher ability children identifying fractions and multiplication and division. Titans class show a great enthusiasm for their maths sessions, and thoroughly enjoy discovering their maths through a practical approach such as song and rhyme, allowing our children to achieve new things.



## World of Work

This term, our world of work weeks has made a return, giving the children opportunities to explore their interests in the working world. We've had the pleasure to be visited by Rossendale pet and reptile rescue, African drummers, Cricketer, HGV driver, Police and Firefighters, and also had to opportunity to pet some lambs. The children did a fantastic job at meeting new people and making them feel welcome, whilst trying new things to improve their development. We are very proud of how they approached these exciting activities.



## Interventions (Personal and social development)

A few times a week, we have continued with a range of interventions, to provide our children with the opportunity to develop their communication, cognition, independence and physical development, all skills that will help them continue onto new things.
