### English.

This term in English we read 'The Whole Truth', the children enjoyed this book and it gave us the opportunity to discuss why it is important to tell the truth. We also read 'Stig of the Dump' which Titans class loved. We looked at nouns, verbs and adjectives and wrote our own chapters about the characters Barney and Stig. During creative we took inspiration from this book and made our own dens which was lots of fun!



## Maths.

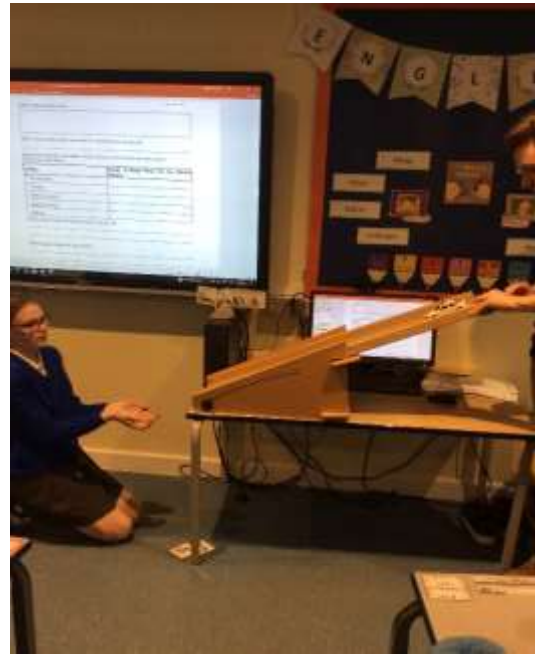
This term in Maths we have been looking at fractions, we learned how to recognise and order fractions. We also looked at scales and worked hard to solve problems when measuring litres and millilitres.

This term Titans class participated in Number Day and they had great fun solving number problems in the forest and playing number names in the hall.



## Science.

In Science this term we have been looking at forces and magnets. We performed an experiment to investigate the effects of friction on different surfaces, we did this by rolling a toy car down a ramp covered in different materials. The children really enjoyed this experiment and made some great predictions about which surface would create the most friction.



### Topic.

In topic this term we have been looking at our wonderful world! We enjoyed designing our own community gardens using the laptops. Titans have also been learning about internet safety and how to keep ourselves safe online. We have been learning about how to look after our bodies and thought about how to stay positive. We also designed our own 'Eatwell' plates including lots of healthy foods.
