

# Titans

## Autumn 2022.

Titans have had a fantastic start to the new school year. The children have settled in brilliantly and they are working well together as a class. They are working hard and have enjoyed trying new things.

### English.

This term in English we have been looking at fiction and non-fiction texts. We read the story of 'Silly Billy' and discussed the characters. We looked at different types of conjunctions and wrote our own letters. Discussing different characters and their feelings also gave us the opportunity to think about our own worries and how we can help resolve them.

When looking at non-fiction texts we identified features of a report and used this information to write our own non-fiction reports using the laptops.

### Maths.

The children have been working extremely hard in Maths and have been looking at 2D and 3D shapes, recognising and partitioning numbers and estimation. They have also been adding and subtracting numbers using the column method.



### Science.

Our Science topic this term is all about plants. We have identified different parts of a flowering plant, looked at how water is transported in plants and set up our own investigation to find out what plants need to grow well. We planted seeds and watched them grow.



### Topic.

In topic this term we have been learning about Ancient Egypt. We looked at hieroglyphics and learned how to write like an Egyptian. We have also designed our own ancient Egyptian death masks and canopic jars. We talked about different foods and enjoyed tasting

different dips including hummus and garlic dip. We then had great fun designing and creating our own dips such as strawberry-molé! The children were fantastic and really pushed themselves when trying new foods including different tastes and textures.



### Thrive

The children have participated in their Thrive activities with great enthusiasm this term and have enjoyed taking part in cosmic yoga and peer massage. The children have also enjoyed playing board games in pairs and small groups which has encouraged turn-taking and sportsmanship.
