

# Titans.

## Summer 2023.

Titans class have continued to work hard throughout the Summer term. They have enjoyed spending lots of time learning and playing outside in the lovely weather.

### English.

This term in English we have been looking at mystery stories. We read 'Ottoline and the Yellow Cat' which the children really enjoyed. The children made predictions about what would happen in the story and used adjectives to describe their favourite character from the book. The children produced some fantastic work when they created their own mystery stories and also designed their own book covers.



## Maths.

This term in Maths we learned how to solve money problems. We learned how to convert between pounds and pence and how to add and subtract amounts of money.

We have also been learning about shapes and properties of 3D shapes. Titans class enjoyed making their own models of 3D shapes using blocks and art-straws.



## Science.

In Science we have been learning about Skeletons. The children had lots of fun looking at different types of skeletons including endoskeletons and exoskeletons.

During the 'World of Work' week in school the children were eager to show off their knowledge to the radiographer who visited us and she was really impressed with the children's enthusiasm and the understanding they showed.



### Topic.

In Topic this term we have been learning about 'Healthy Humans'. The children had great fun trying to improve their stamina in PE and they had some great ideas about how we can keep our bodies healthy. We looked at the 'Eat Well' plate and discussed which foods we should eat plenty of and which foods should be eaten less often.

As part of this topic we also tasted lots of healthy foods, many of which the children had not tried before. We were so proud of the children as they all participated and evaluated the foods they tried. The children now have some new favourite things to eat including pomegranate!



## Thrive.

The children are continuing to enjoy Thrive activities and work well as a team. The children were really engaged when participating in role play activities. They especially enjoyed dressing up and playing doctors. This activity encouraged the children to use their imagination and also helped them practise turn-taking and waiting.



The highlight of this term was the 'World of Work' week where the children had lots of visitors in school explaining about their jobs and the work they do. This encouraged the children to think about careers and what they would like to do when they're older!
