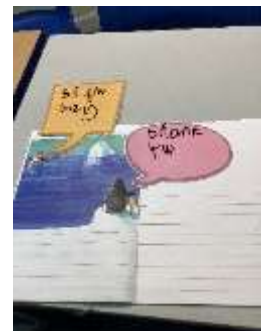


## Wizards Autumn Term

The children in Wizards have had a very busy start to the school year but they have all settled well into their cabin classroom. They have learned new routines and have enjoyed greater freedom when learning outdoors.

### English

In English we have looked at stories by the same author. Our focus has been on Oliver Jeffers and his stories, 'Stuck' and 'Lost and Found'. The children enjoyed learning about penguins and created their own non-chronological report all about penguins and discussed features of non-fiction texts. We have also looked at poetry and how we can incorporate actions during a simple performance. We have looked at different types of punctuation such as capital letters and full stops. We have also focussed on extending our sentences to include adjectives for description and verbs.



### Maths

In maths we have looked at a variety of different topics, we started working on recognising numbers and place value then moved onto addition and subtraction. We used different equipment to help us with addition and subtraction. We worked really hard to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. We have also looked at using apparatus to measure length and capacity.



## Science

We have been exploring animals and how we can group the different categories based on their features and diets. We looked at where the different animals might live either in the sea or on land. We also looked at adult animals and their offspring. We made our own animals out of paper plates.



## Forest School

All the children have enjoyed all the activities completed in the forest this term, even if we did get a little wet and muddy at times. We learnt how to plant bulbs, walk along a balance rope, find different bugs and how to make a broomstick.



## Thrive

In thrive the children have been having fun in their groups. Some children have been exploring the outside and how to cross apparatus. Another group has focussed on actions

having consequences and created a stop motion to prevent bullying. One group has focused on turn taking when playing a range of games.
