

Standards Committee Terms of Reference

Membership:

The committee shall consist of no less than three governors, including the Headteacher (or substitute nominated by the Headteacher).

Quorum:

Quorum of three governors, of which the Headteacher (or substitute) must be one.

Meetings:

The committee shall meet three times a year, and otherwise as required.

Meeting timetable to be agreed each July for the following academic year.

Terms of Reference:

To provide guidance and assistance to the Headteacher and the Governing Body on all matters relating to school curriculum and their statutory obligations regarding the National Curriculum;

With the assistance of staff to provide information to the full Governing Body about how the curriculum is taught, evaluated and resourced;

To review the policy and provision for relationship education and make recommendations to the full Governing Body;

To ensure that the requirements of children with special needs are met through establishing and monitoring the Schools Local Offer;

To review information and data regarding school performance including KS2 results;

To oversee targets for pupil achievement and progress;

To be involved in the monitoring of achievement, progress and assessment throughout the school;

To monitor the use of Pupil Premium funding and its impact;

To contribute towards the curriculum area of the School Development Plan;

To receive reports from the Headteacher and Subject Leads on the delivery of the curriculum;

To consider complaints relating to the curriculum and to advise the Governing Body

To agree on a policy and protocol for governor visits to the school.

To attend or commission appropriate governor training;

The Chair (or substitute) will report to the full Governing Body at each meeting;

The full Governing Body will review annually the establishment, membership and terms of reference of this sub-committee.
