Vocabulary

weather	The day to day conditions of the atmosphere e.g. wind, rain and snow.
seasons	The main times of year which can be divided and which have their own typical weather.
autumn	The season between summer and winter when the weather becomes colder and the leaves fall off trees.
winter	The season between autumn and spring when the weather is usually cold.
plant	A living thing that grows in the earth and has a stem leaves, and roots.
deciduous	A tree that loses its leaves in the autumn every year.
evergreen	A tree or bush which has green leaves all the year round.
flower	The part of a plant which is often brightly coloured and grows at the end of a stem
stem	The thin, upright part of a plant on which the flowers and leaves grow.
seed	The small, hard part from which a new plant grows.
bulb	A root shaped like an onion that grows into a flower or plant.
roots	The parts of a plant that grow under the ground.
branch	Parts that grow out from the tree trunk and have leaves, flowers, or fruit growing on them.
trunk	The large main stem from which the branches grow.
common	Something that is found in large numbers or happens often.
wild	Animals or plants that live or grow in natural surroundings and are not looked after by people.
