Dear parents/carers,

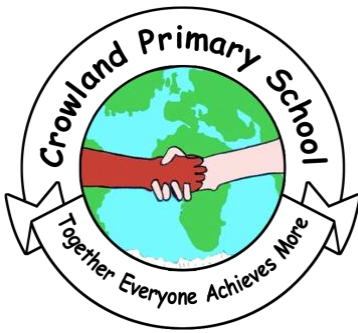
You will be aware from media coverage and from previous letters sent, that the national union of teachers NEU, are continuing with strike action. The next two action days will take place on the 5th July and 7th July 2023. These strikes continue because of ongoing disputes between the unions and the government over teachers' pay and school funding.

We would like to inform you that Crowland Primary School will be closed on Wednesday 5th July and Friday 7th July 2023. We are asking you not to send your child into school on these dates.

As in the previous strike action days, each school has had to make an independent decision based on their individual circumstances. We remain committed to providing a safe and secure environment for our pupils and feel that based on our risk assessment we would be unable to provide this with the staff we will have available.

As a school we are advised to provide care for a small number of children who meet the threshold for priority provision. Such families will be notified by the school.

As on previous occasions, students who are eligible for a free school meal, should they require it will be provided for. These students will arrive at the Breakfast Club entrance between 11.30 and 12.00 which is on the slip road.



We are sorry that you will have to make alternative arrangements for your child at short notice, and that they will experience disruption to their education but we also acknowledge the work of our teachers and all their efforts. I understand that this situation may be frustrating and

ask that all members of our school community continue to treat each other with respect and due consideration.

We continue to work closely with our staff union representatives to keep up to date with the situation, and we will inform you as soon as possible if arrangements change further.
