**SATs Tests for Year 6 pupils will take place between Monday 9<sup>th</sup> May and Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> May 2022.**

**The children are expected to be in school at 8.45am from Monday 9<sup>th</sup> May to Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> May 2022.**

During this week, children will sit tests in:

- Reading
- Maths
- Spelling, punctuation and grammar

### Timetable of tests

Monday 9 <sup>th</sup> May 2022	Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar: Paper 1- Short Answer (45 minutes) Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar: Paper 2- Spelling Test (15 minutes)
Tuesday 10 <sup>th</sup> May 2022	Reading (1 hour)
Wednesday 11 <sup>th</sup> May 2022	Maths Paper 1: Arithmetic (30 minutes) Maths Paper 2: Reasoning (40 minutes)
Thursday 12 <sup>th</sup> May 2022	Maths Paper 3: Reasoning (40 minutes)

### How to support your child

It is essential that your child attends school every day. For each morning of the SATs, we will be providing the Year 6 pupils with breakfast snacks. **Please also ensure that your children have breakfast in the morning before arriving to school and bring a water bottle with them.** The children are expected to be in school at 8.45am to help them prepare and relax. All of the Year 6 team will be there to make sure children feel ready for the test that day.



The weekend before the tests, please support your child to recap key learning and help your child to relax. Make sure that they have an early night and feel fully rested for each day of the SATs.

The SATs are a snapshot of what your child has learnt in primary school and the results depend on how well they perform on the day.

Your children have worked incredibly hard this year and we wish them the best of luck in their SATS.
