

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are forwarding some information in relation to the new school year and to kindly remind you of the usual school expectations. Children return to school on **Wednesday 7th September**.

New Drop-Off and Pick Up Arrangements

After the pandemic restrictions we are happy to review our in-school arrangements by creating generic start and finishing times for all pupils. We are pleased to be announcing new 'soft start' arrangements in the new school year. We kindly ask that children are dropped off in the mornings between the times of **8:45 and 9:00 and picked up by 3:15**. All children <u>must be in class by 9:00</u> ready to start the school day. This is to ease transition arrangements in the morning and avoid unnecessary waiting time outside or inside school.

Breakfast Club and After School Club:

This provision will run as usual.

Breakfast Club from 7:45 and After School Club till 6:00. We continue to offer wrap-around care to all our Nursery pupils as well as to our Reception pupils.

School Uniform:

Children must wear purple tops with the Crowland School badge. Green uniforms are gradually being phased out so if you are buying a new uniform please adhere to purple. Grey tights and socks as well as sensible black shoes (not trainers unless it is PE Day). In line with our inclusive ethos we want to discourage any misunderstandings arising from competing commercial brands. Please avoid shoes with highly visible brand names for every day shoes. Trainers can only be worn during PE sessions. Please also ensure that <u>all uniform items are labelled with your child's name</u> otherwise there is no way of reclaiming any items.





Jewellery

We discourage the wearing of earrings and jewellery as this can lead to injury during play and PE sessions.

School Attendance

During the pandemic we have exercised extended flexibility to families regarding travel, authorisation of absence and issuing of fines relating to poor attendance. We would like to emphasise that the school will be taking a much more stringent approach to monitoring attendance and authorising absence. Cases of persistent absentees will be reported to the school's Educational Welfare Officer and may be subjected to social services intervention and court proceedings.
