**Information regarding remote learning**

Dear Parent/ Carer,

We hope you are well and keeping safe at home. As you are aware Early Years children will be isolating at home until **Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> November**. Therefore, we will be providing remote learning for you to do with your child at home.

Today, you will be set up on Class Dojo which is an educational platform that allows communication between home and school. It also enables us to post work for the children to complete at home along with other supportive materials such as story videos. Please look out for an activation email, which will be sent to you shortly.

We will be asking you to record any home learning on Tapestry which was set up before the October half term. If you are still yet to set this up with a username and password, please also look out for an activation email. Posting on Tapestry is very simple, but please contact us if you are having trouble with this.

The learning provided by the class teachers will be in keeping with your child's class topic for this half term and will cover all areas of the Early Years curriculum. We will also provide useful links to support with the planning document. Please remember that children in the Early Years learn practically and need concrete objects to help them understand concepts. Talk with an adult is also key for facilitating their learning at home.

Your child's Class teacher will be contactable between school hours 9:00am to 3:00pm via Dojo or Tapestry. Parents can also email the front desk with any other queries.

If you do not have access to WIFI or a computer at home, please let the school office know so we can look into supporting you with this.
