Dear Parent/Carers,

We have recently been experiencing a degree of staff absence due to the current circumstances like many other schools. This is unfortunately a direct consequence of the current pandemic climate. As a school we opt for a robustly safe approach in protecting our children and our staff team from any avoidable risk in transmission and spread of infection.

There continue to be occasions where staff are having to isolate under different circumstances. They may have to isolate due to the national 'Track and Trace' system if they have come into close contact with an infected individual, or they may have to isolate due to an infected household member. If a staff member is diagnosed as COVID positive, you will be informed immediately and if your child has come into close contact with them they will also be asked to isolate by the school.

For members of staff having to isolate outside of the 'bubble', this is a result of outside contacts where the school has directed them to refrain from coming into work as stipulated in our risk assessment.

I am sure you appreciate the unprecedented circumstances and understand that as a school, we are doing our utmost best to protect our school community and our children as far as possible.
