Updated guidance: If your child has any of the following symptoms cough, fever, loss of taste and smell:

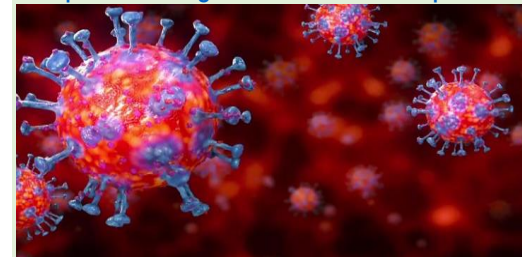
1. Keep your child at home and notify school immediately
2. Arrange for your child to have a PCR test
3. If your child tests positive, notify the school immediately and keep them at home for at least 5 days
4. Return your child to school on the 6th day after two consecutive negative LFD tests

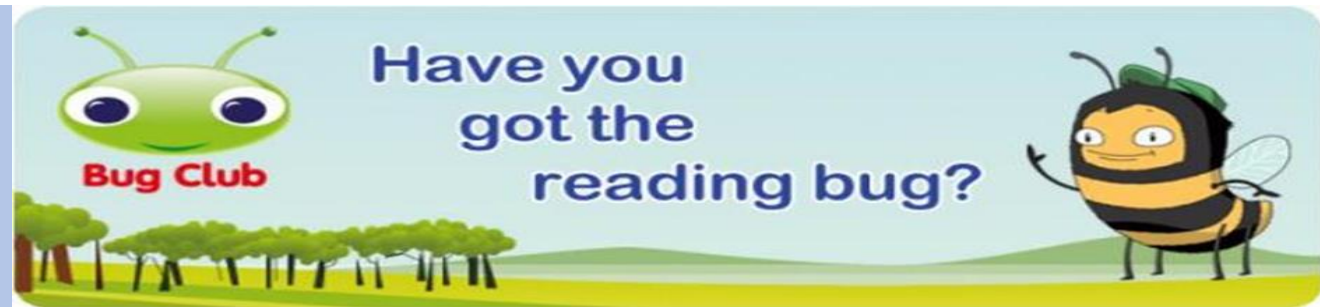
