


Dear Parents and Carers,

If your child attends school and has any of the following symptoms <u>cough, fever, loss</u> <u>of taste and smell</u>:

- 1. Keep your child at home and notify school <u>immediately</u>
- 2. Arrange for your child to have a COVID test
- 3. If your child tests positive, notify the school <u>immediately</u> and keep them at home for at least 10 days
- 4. Make sure the whole household isolates for 14 days
- 5. If another household member tests positive your child must also isolate for 14 days.

The lyrics are about Jerusalem being a 'spiritual home'. Jerusalem is considered to be a holy pilgrimage for many faiths including Christianity, Judaism and Islam. For us in Crowland, the song represents the bringing together of different faiths, cultures and languages just like our school community.
