Dear Parents

Thank you for collecting your children on Wednesday 7th July with regard to our Schools bubble bursting. One of our staff members tested positive on their PCR test and was in close proximity with the whole school on Monday and Tuesday. Having spoken to Public Health England we were advised to close the school. All staff and pupils are to go into 10 days of isolation due to the potential incubation period. You are welcome to seek a PCR test and carry on with LFT tests. However, if the test comes back negative your child is still required to isolate for the 10 days.

If your child develops symptoms then defiantly seek out a test and please let me know so that I can update staff and parents (r.aindow@cumbriaacademyforautism.org.uk).

We would have finished for the summer term on Thursday 15th July; this is certainly not the ending anyone would have wanted for the term and year, but what a year it has been with the ongoing challenges of COVID. Staff teams will continue to be in touch over the next 10 day's checking in with you and providing support and home school learning work as required.

Thank you for your understanding and we will be sending out information with regard to next year as soon as we can.
