Dear Parents,

There is a lot of conflicting information at the moment from Government, Council and Schools. Please be aware we are all trying to work together to safeguard and do the best that we can for each other and all of our children. These are unprecedented times.

It has been agreed with Cumbria County Council that the SEN schools had to close due to increasingly low staffing levels. We would not have enough staff in school to support the pupils appropriately past Friday 20th March. The safety of our children is of the upmost importance, and it was for this reason we made the decision to close.

The government yesterday announced that schools will stay open in some capacity. This will be to provide childcare for those children who have parents who are classified as 'Key Workers', including NHS Staff, Social Workers and delivery drivers. The council is currently trying to put a strategy together to make this government announcement workable.
