God had called Moses to lead the Israelites out of Egypt. They escaped Egypt by coming through the red sea which had been parted by God. Moses was a reluctant leader (he had a speech disorder, struggled with speaking and confidence) but God told him He would be with him.

God was faithful to the Israelites (parting the red sea and helping them to escape and God had then kept providing them with food each day.) However the Israelites would trust God and choose to follow God one day and then the next they would mess up (bit like us saying we will change, choose to do the right thing and then mess up again) Each time God welcomed them back. They were also really critical of Moses and it was hard for him to keep going as their leader but God promised to be with him as this verse shows.
