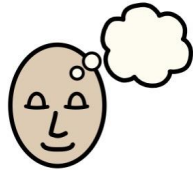
# Our Worries

3: I'm going on a sponsored walk this weekend. I just hope I don't let everyone down by getting too tired and giving up!





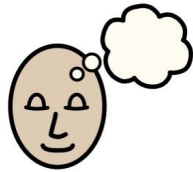
