

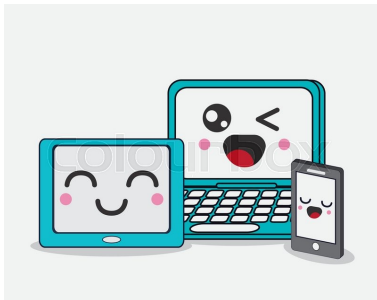
Online Safety Agreement
