In 2000, she was made a Dame Commander of the Order of the British Empire for her contribution to the arts.

Shirley is from a mixed-race family as her mother is English and her father is Nigerian. Racial discrimination was a

constant issue.

She had to leave school at the age of 16 to start work in a factory.
