Did you know that the Bible talks about Jesus when he was just a kid? In this story, you'll meet Jesus the twelve year old and his parents, Joseph and Mary.

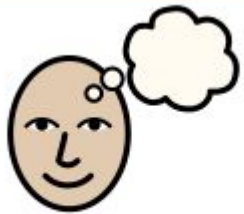
