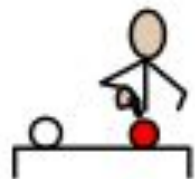
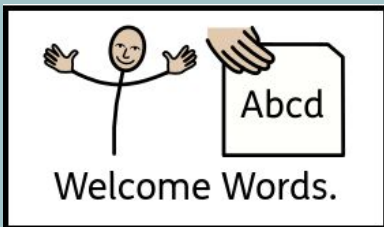

What do you think you would discover if you met Jesus?



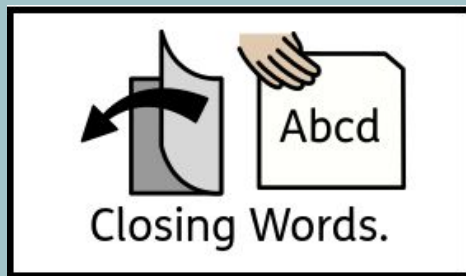
