## Attendance:

At Daven Primary School, you should aim for your child to get 100% attendance, and to be in school on time. We might have to contact Cheshire East Council if your child has 10 or more unauthorised absences – this is with a view to issue a fixed penalty notice. The penalty notice is issued individually to each parent/carer who fails to ensure their child's regular attendance and is £60 if you pay within 21 days. If you fail to pay, it may result in prosecution.
