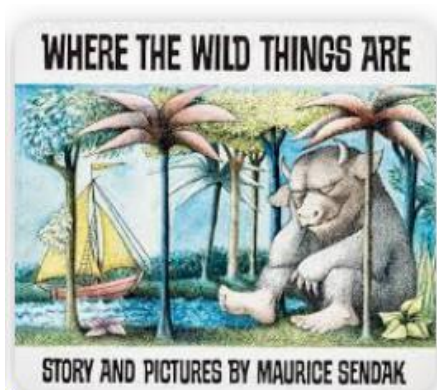


Recommended Reads By Daven Primary School

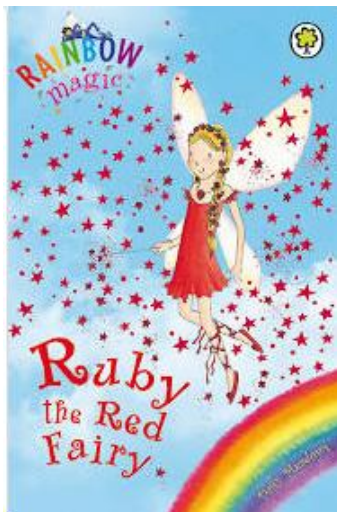
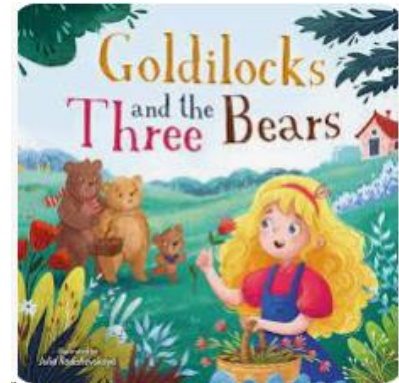

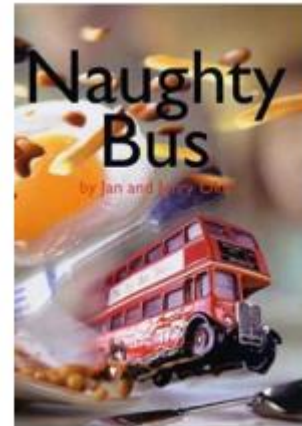
