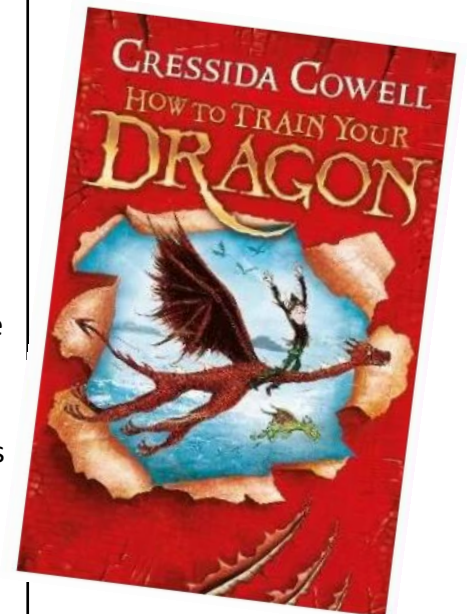


Have you read How to Train your Dragon?

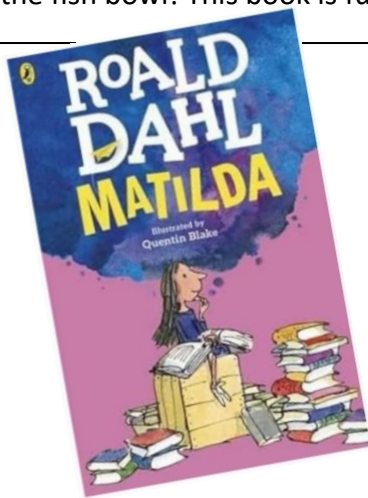
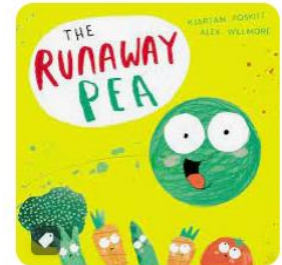
Book reviews

Matilda by Roald Dahl



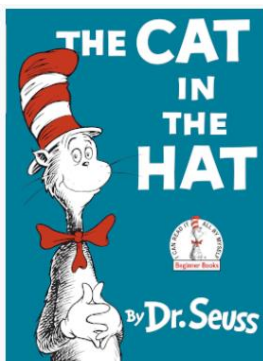
