Taking Children Out Of School During Term Time

A very important message for all parents. We will not authorise parents taking children out of school during term time for family holidays. Such leave may risk families receiving a penalty notice or legal action being taken. Should a penalty notice be issued, each parent will be fined a minimum of £60 or £120 depending on how soon payment is made. If the fine is not paid, you may be required to attend Court and this could result in a fine for each parent of up to £1000 per child and a Criminal Record.
