### Summer Fair



If you would like to hire a stall at our Summer Fair on Tuesday 9th July, please contact our School Office ASAP. There will be a charge of £20 per stall. If you require access to electricity there will be an additional £5 charge per socket. Please also provide a raffle prize to the school prior to the day of the summer fair.



Children who are new to Year 3 in September will no longer be in receipt of free school meals as the Government only provide free school meals up to the end of Year 2. If you would like your child to still have a school meal when they enter Key Stage 2, the cost will be £12.50 per week, which should be paid on parent pay. If you think, you may be entitled to free school meals you will need to fill online application form on LCC website [CLICK HERE](#). Thank you.

### Taking Children Out Of School During Term Time

A very important message for all parents. We will not authorise parents taking children out of school during term time for family holidays. Such leave may risk families receiving a penalty notice or legal action being taken. Should a penalty notice be issued, each parent will be fined a minimum of £60 or £120 depending on how soon payment is made. If the fine is not paid, you may be required to attend Court and this could result in a fine for each parent of up to £1000 per child and a Criminal Record.
