



Pupils Agreement/ Online-safety rules.

The following rules reflect our e-safety Policy. It is important that parents/carers read and discuss the following statements with their child(ren), understanding and agreeing to follow the school rules on using ICT, included use of the internet.

- I will only use ICT in school for school purposes.
- I will only use the internet when there is an adult that I trust with me.
- I will only use ICT in school for my school work.
- I will only use my class e-mail address when I e-mail someone.
- I will only click on buttons or links if I know what they do.
- I will only open and delete my own file once I have asked an adult.
- I will ask an adult if I get lost on the internet.
- I will use Hector the Protector if I see something I don't like.
- I will not bring to school any mobile phones or games consoles from home.
- I will not deliberately look for, or access inappropriate websites.
- I will not tell others my ICT passwords.
- I will not attempt to install anything onto the school network.
- I will not give out details about myself or others, such as names, phone numbers or where I live.
- I will not arrange to meet anyone I have met online.
- I understand that my use of ICT can be checked and my parents/carers contacted if a member of staff is concerned about my eSafety.
