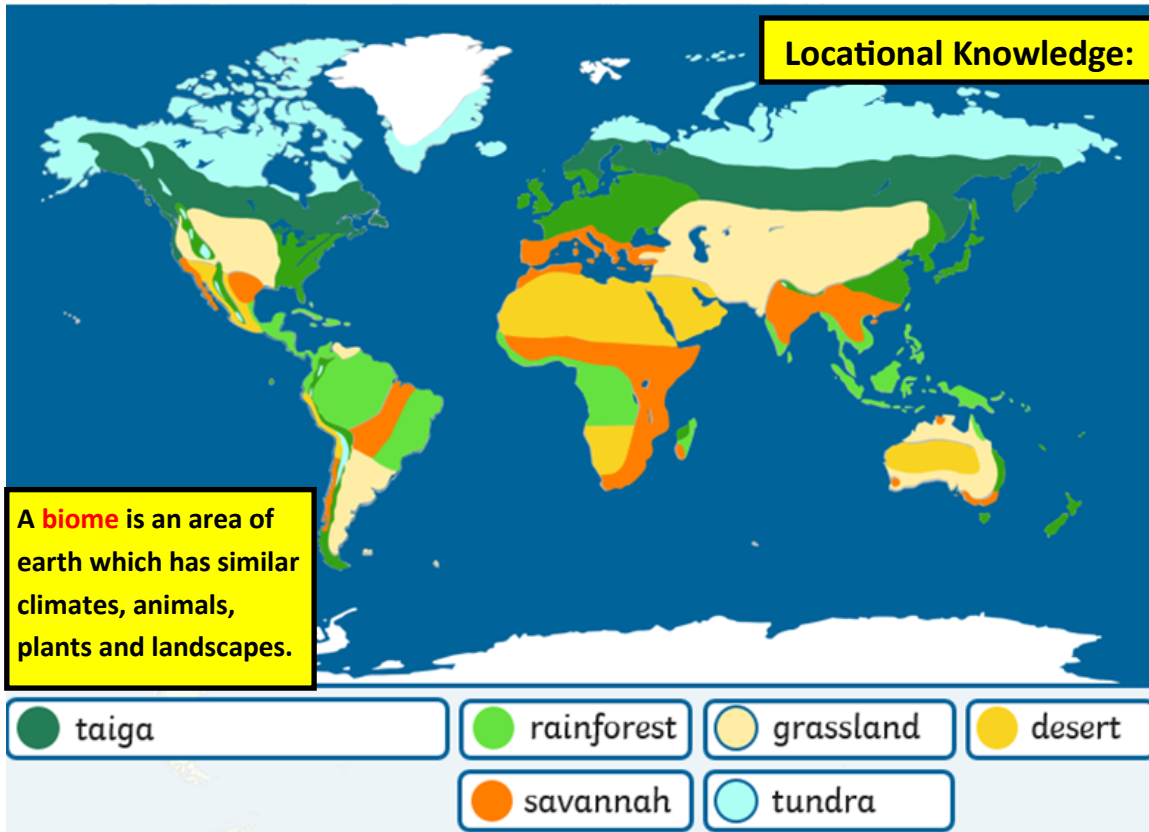


## Biomes Around the World



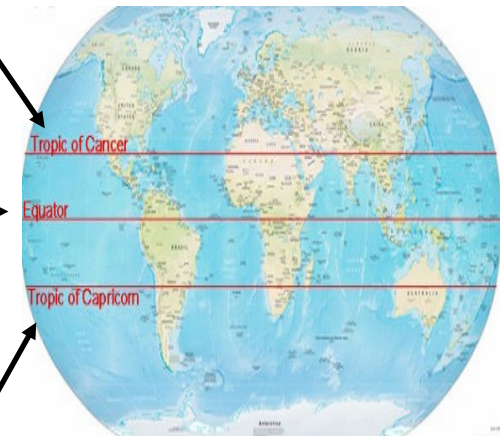
### More facts:

- **Climate** is the weather pattern observed over a length of time - usually 30 years.
- **Climate zones** are areas around the world with specific patterns of weather.
- **Global warming** is the increase in the Earth's average temperature over a period of time.
- Human activities contribute to global warming which impact on the biomes.
- The further you get from the Earth's equator the cooler the temperature.

The **tropic of cancer** is the start of the northern hemisphere.

The **equator** is the imaginary great circle around the earth.

The **tropic of Capricorn** is the start of the southern hemisphere.



**Longitude:** imaginary lines that run from the North to the south Pole.

**Latitude:** The distance north or south of the equator.
