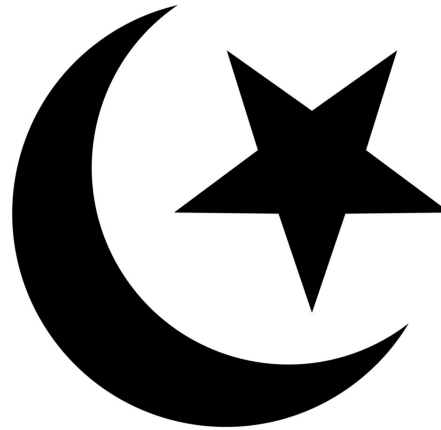
There are four areas of work: emergency help, building independent communities, education and healthcare.
