

Know how to use four-figure grid referencing



The Alps

The Alps are a large mountain range in the middle of Europe. They spread over eight countries. The highest mountain in the Alps is Mont Blanc. Tourism is the main industry in the Alps. Around 30 million people visit each year.





A 4 –figure grid reference contains with 4 numbers. The first two numbers are called eastings and the second two numbers are called northings.

The Lake District

The Lake District is a national park and World Heritage Site in north west England. It is home to the high mountain in England—Scafell Pike and the deepest lake— Wastwater, It is popular with tourists because of its beautiful mountains and lakes.
