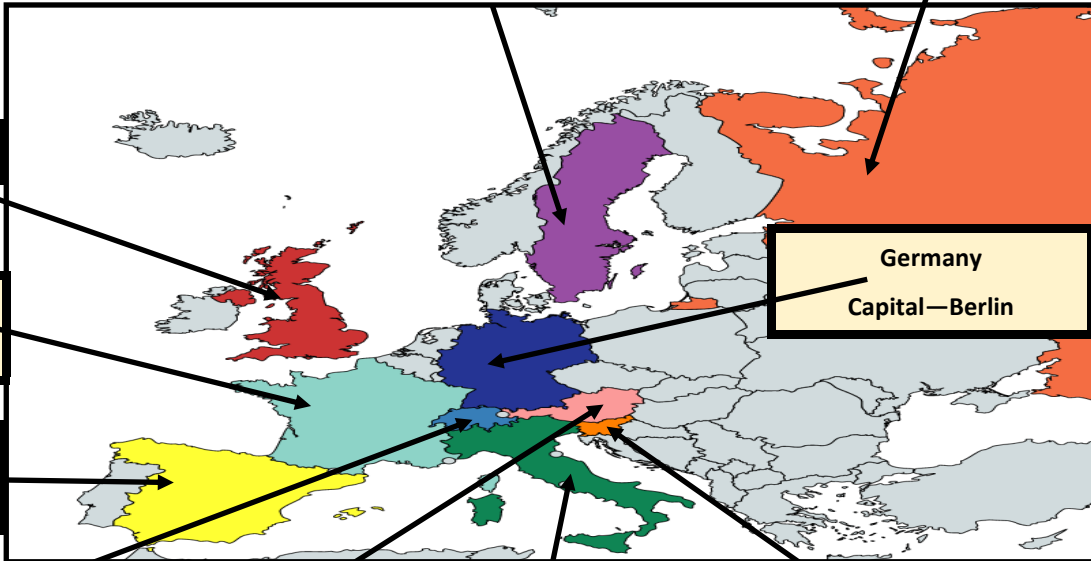

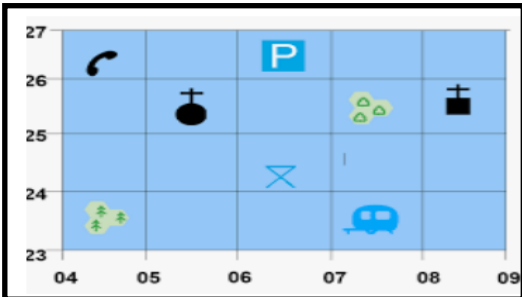

Know how to use four-figure grid referencing



The Alps

The Alps are a large mountain range in the middle of Europe. They spread over eight countries. The highest mountain in the Alps is **Mont Blanc**. Tourism is the main industry in the Alps. Around 30 million people visit each year.



A 4-figure grid reference contains with 4 numbers. The first two numbers are called eastings and the second two numbers are called northings.

The Lake District

The Lake District is a national park and World Heritage Site in north west England. It is home to the high mountain in England—**Scafell Pike** and the deepest lake—**Wastwater**, It is popular with tourists because of its beautiful mountains and lakes.
