

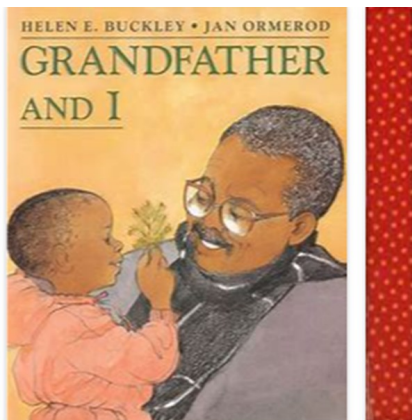


What will I know at the end of the unit?
