- 1. This form is valid for the period of time your child attends this school. Your consent will automatically cease after this time.
- 2. The school will not use personal details or full names (which means first name and surname) of any child or adult in a photographic image, on video, on our website, in the school prospectus or in any of our other printed publications.
- 3. The school will not include personal e-mail or postal addresses or telephone or fax numbers on video, on our website, in our school prospectus or in other printed publications.
- 4. If we use photographs of individual pupils, we will not use the full name of that child in any accompanying text or caption.
- 5. If we use the full name of pupil in the text, we will not use a photograph of that child to accompany the article.
- 6. We may include pictures of pupils and teachers that have been drawn by pupils. We may use group or class photographs or footage with very general labels, such as "a science lesson".
- 7. Teaching/College students on placement take photographs for use only by the college.
- 8. We will only use images of pupils who are suitably dressed.
- 9. Parents should note that websites are viewed throughout the world and not just in the United Kingdom where UK law applies.
- 10. Notes on Use of Images by the media If you give permission for your child's image to be used by the media then you should be aware that
- The media will want to use any printed or broadcast media pictures that they take alongside the relevant story;
- It is likely that they will want to publish the child's name, age and the school name in the caption for the picture (possible exceptions to this are large

group or team photographs);

- It is possible that the newspaper will re-publish the story on their website, or distribute it more widely to other newspapers or media organisations.
