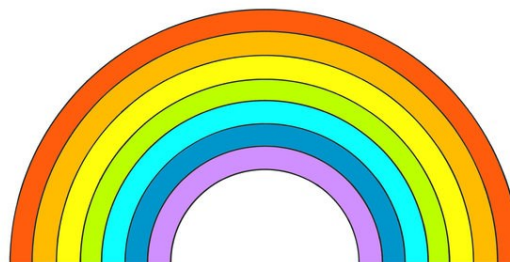


Promise	Telling someone you will definitely not do something.

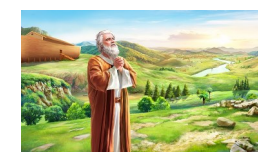
