

## Our Responsibilities

## Main function is to facilitate the removal of barriers to learning.

- One to one intervention sessions.
- Focus group work sessions.
- Parent groups
- Promote attendance / meetings.
- Parent consultations, when issues arise.
- Termly review meetings with teaching staff to monitor pupil progress.
- Home visits for attendance.
- Lunchtime duty. Supporting children with challenging behaviour.
- Manage behaviour / be a visible point of contact both before school and at home time.




- Working with pupils to identify the cause of an issues / problem and implementing positive strategies to enable the pupil to fulfil their potential in all areas of development.
