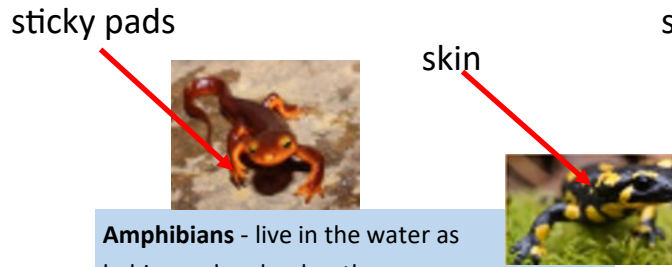




fur

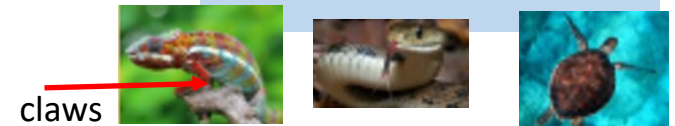
Reptiles - all breathe air. They have scales on their skin.

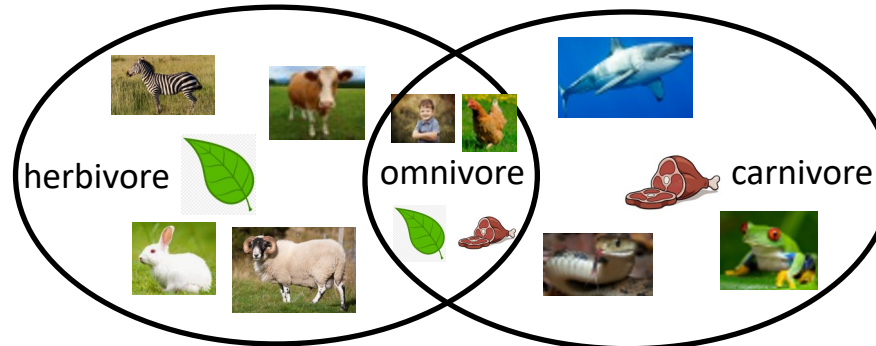
