If you are not signed up to Class Dojo please take your mobile to the school office and they will offer help. There is lots of important information sent this way.


Home Learning will be set every Friday on Purple Mash and Class Dojo.

Every week there will be a Reading, Spelling and Maths task that the children are expected to complete.

There will be a weekly Spelling Test related to the important Year 2 words.

Phonics/Reading

Phonics and **Spelling** are at the heart of the Year 2 curriculum. In addition to daily phonics sessions the children are given the opportunity to apply their skills within Guided Reading.



In Year 2 the children develop more fluency and stamina in order to read and understand longer texts.

The children will explore the mean of unfamiliar words - grinned.

What do you think the word grinned might mean?






The children will read a text and swer questions about what they have just read.

Writing

In Year 2 the children use a range of exciting, ambitious texts in order to develop and build on the writing foundations from Year 1.

- -Full-stops and capital letters used correctly
- -Exclamation and question marks used correctly
 - -Adjectives, nouns and verbs used correctly

In addition, there is an increased focus on the use of a correct and neat handwriting style.







At Deepdale we block Maths topics across the year.

Number - Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, Multiplication and Division and Fractions.


Measurement - Money, Length and Height, Time, Mass, Capacity and Temperature

Geometry - Properties of Shape, Position and Direction

Statistics


Addition

Add a two-digit number and ones; a two digit number and tens; two two-digit numbers and three one-digit numbers.



Subtraction


Subtract a two-digit number and ones; a two-digit number and tens and two two-digit numbers.



Multiplication


Calculate multiplication statements and write them using (x) and equals (=) signs.

Children should understand and be able to calculate multiplication as repeated addition, supported by practical equipment.



Division

Calculate division within the multiplication tables and write them using the division (÷) and equals (=) signs.
