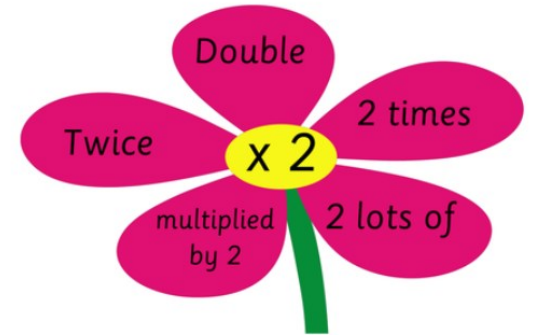

 $10 - 6 = 4$

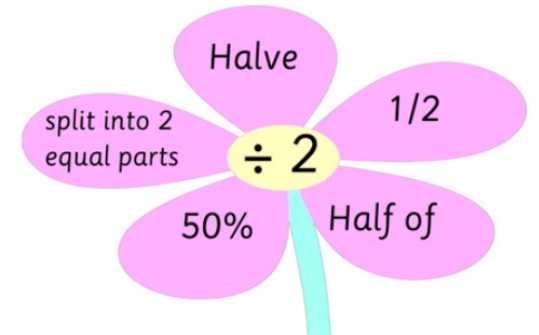
$5 + 5 = 10$

Recall doubles and corresponding halves for all numbers up to 10

double 1 is 2 $1 + 1 = 2$
double 5 is 10 $5 + 5 = 10$
