Phonics/Reading

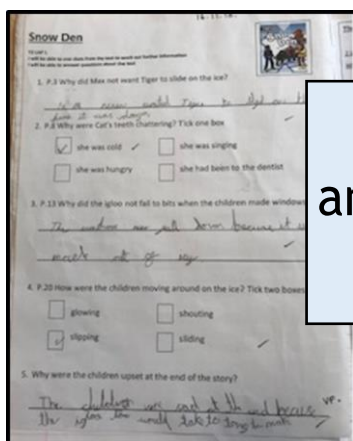
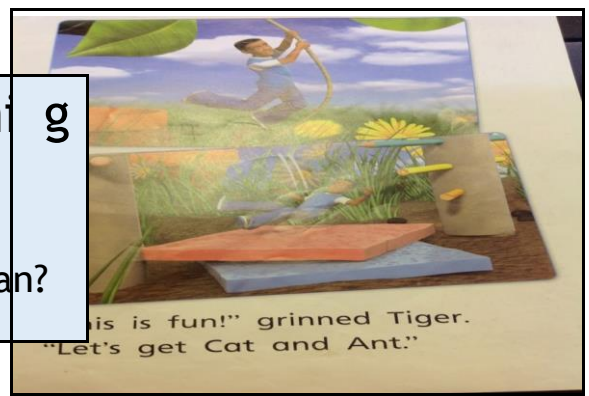
Phonics is at the heart of the Year 2 curriculum. In addition to daily phonics sessions the children are given the opportunity to apply their skills within Guided Reading.



In Year 2 the children develop more fluency and stamina in order to read and understand longer texts.

The children will explore the meaning of unfamiliar words - **grinned**.

What do you think the word grinned might mean?



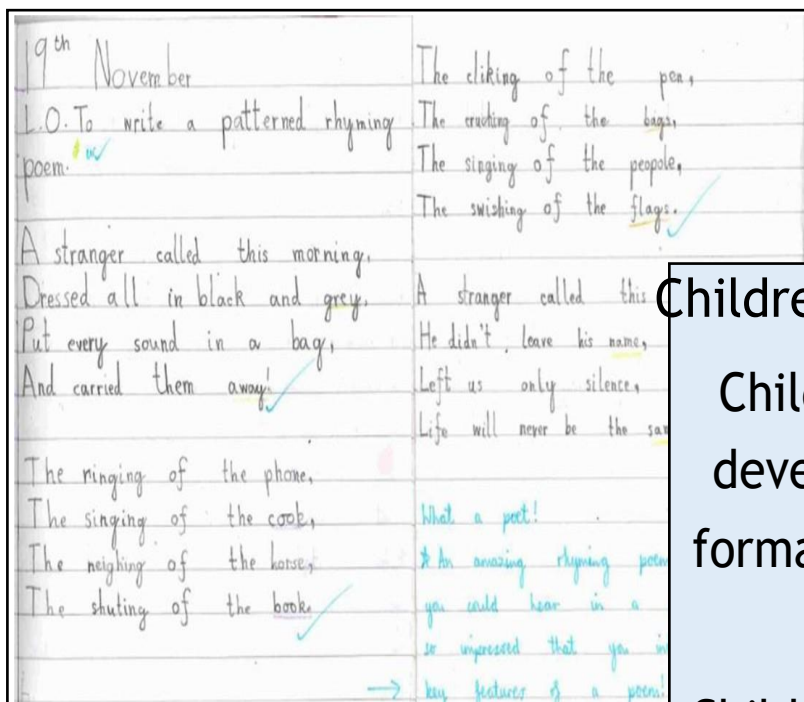
The children will read a text and answer questions about what they have just read.

W riting

In Year 2 the children use a range of exciting, ambitious texts in order to develop and build on the writing foundations from Year 1.

- Full-stops and capital letters used correctly
- Exclamation and question marks used correctly
- Adjectives, nouns and verbs used correctly

In addition, there is an increased focus on the use of a correct and neat handwriting style.



Children will write in pencil.

Children will continue to develop the correct letter formation and a consistent size.

Children will move towards a joined style in Summer.

Maths



At Deepdale we block Maths topics across the year.

Number - Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, Multiplication and Division and Fractions.

Measurement - Money, Length and Height, Time, Mass, Capacity and Temperature

Geometry - Properties of Shape, Position and Direction

Statistics

Addition

Add a two-digit number and ones; a two digit number and tens; two two-digit numbers and three one-digit numbers.

$32 + 21 =$

The children make individual amounts, counting the tens first and then counting the ones.

53

Subtraction

Subtract a two-digit number and ones; a two-digit number and tens and two two-digit numbers.

$54 - 23 =$

The children count out 54 using Base 10 equipment and then remove 3 ones and 2 tens. which leaves

Multiplication

Calculate multiplication statements and write them using (x) and equals (=) signs.

Children should understand and be able to calculate multiplication as repeated addition, supported by practical equipment.

$5 \times 3 =$

arrays

$3 + 3 + 3 + 3 + 3 = 15$

$5 + 5 + 5 = 15$

Division

Calculate division within the multiplication tables and write them using the division (\div) and equals (=) signs.

$12 \div 3 =$

The children will learn that this calculation reads as
How many groups of 3 are there in 12?

The children will then move onto the link between sharing and grouping.
