Important Quote: "I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me."

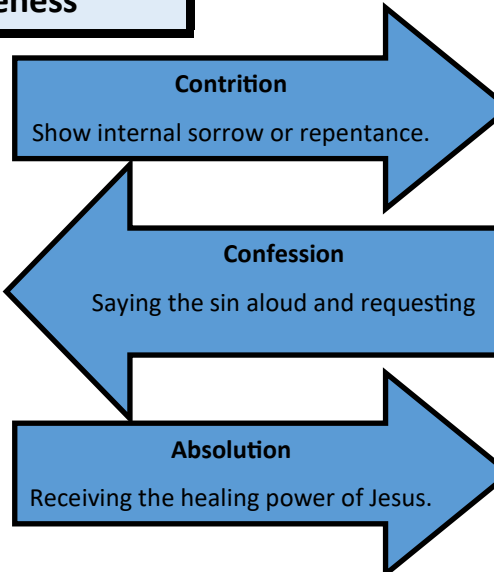
Luke 23:34 speaks of the importance of forgiveness.

These stages are the basis of The Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Confession	An admission or statement of guilt.
Repent	Show deep regret and remorse about the actions committed.

Sacrament	A formal religious routine.

### Confession

In Catholic Churches, this is known as The Sacrament of Reconciliation.

#### The Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Confession of Sin	Saying what you have done
Penance is given	Priest will give you something to do that will make up for the sin
Prayer of Pardon	Showing remorse. Also known as
Absolution	Sins forgiven by God

Christians believe there are many benefits to Confession. Including forgiveness for sins and increasing chances of a life in Heaven after death.

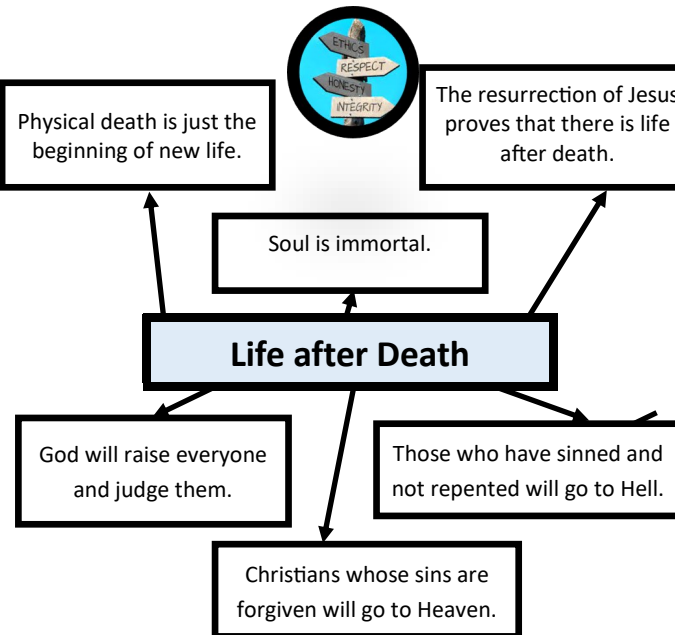
During this ritual, the person confessing will sit with the Priest.
