Year 3 Maths Non-negotiables

Fluency in Counting Targets	Date Achieved
I can count in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100.	
I can count up and down in tenths.	
Place Value	
I can say what each digit represents in a 3 digit number.	
I can partition 3 digit numbers in different ways. e.g. 146 = 100 + 40 + 6 and 146 = 130 + 16	
I can compare and order 3 digit numbers to 1000.	
I can find 1, 10 or 100 more or less than any given number.	
Rapid Recall	
I can recall addition and subtraction facts for 100 (multiples of 5 and 10) e.g. 65+35, 70+30	
I can recall my 3, 4 and 8 times tables and related division facts.	
Calculations: Addition and Subtraction	
I can add and subtract mentally 3-digit numbers and ones e.g. 256+8	
I can add and subtract mentally 3-digit numbers and tens e.g. 453+ 40	
I can add and subtract mentally 3-digit numbers and hundreds e.g. 378+500	
I can add and subtract numbers with up to 3-digits using written columnar method.	
Calculations: Multiplication and Division	
I can work out and use doubles of all numbers to 100 and corresponding halves. e.g. double 54	
I can multiply a 2-digit by a 1-digit number using the grid method.	
I can work out the answer to division statements using the multiplication tables that I know, including for 2-digit numbers	
e.g. 52÷4= Fractions:	
I can find and write fractions of a set of objects: unit fractions 1/8 and non-unit fractions 3/8	
I can add and subtract fractions with the same denominator within one whole.	



Year 3 Reading Non-negotiables

Word reading	Date Achieved
I can read, understand and spell all words from the Year 3 Word List.	
I can accurately read brown banded books with greater fluency and confidence.	
I can read and explain words containing suffixes –ly, -ous.	
I can read and explain words containing prefixes un-, dis-, mis-, re-, pre-, im-, in	
Developing pleasure in reading and motivation to read	
I read books for a range of purposes e.g. enjoyment, research.	
I listen to someone else reading a whole novel aloud to me.	
I can orally retell a range of less familiar stories e.g. fables, folk tales.	
I can discuss themes e.g. rich and poor, good over evil, wish or foolish.	
I can prepare poems and play scripts to read aloud.	
Understanding the text	
I can use a dictionary to check the meaning of a word.	
I take note of punctuation when reading with expression aloud.	
I can identify and discuss the purpose and key ideas in a paragraph.	
I can analyse and evaluate texts looking at language, structure and presentation e.g. persuasive letters, diaries.	
I always justify my responses to a question about a book by using	
evidence from what I have read including when I make inferences. Retrieving and recording information from non-fiction	
I can prepare for research by asking key questions about a subject.	
I can navigate texts in print and on screen.	
Participating in discussion	
I can develop and agree on rules for effective book discussion.

Vocabulary, grammar and punctuation	Date Achieved
I can identify main and subordinate clauses in sentences.	
I can create complex sentences using a range of conjunctions e.g. although	
I can use a comma to separate clauses in sentences.	
I can use inverted commas to punctuate direct speech.	
I can use adverbs e.g. silently, soon, next, eventually, peacefully.	
I can use the perfect form of verbs e.g. 'have' and 'has'.	
Composition	
I can 'magpie' ideas from fiction, non-fiction and poetry.	
I can discuss my ideas and plan my writing in different ways.	
I can create and develop settings, characters and plots for a story.	
I can use powerful verbs, technical language and synonyms in my work.	
I can organise my writing use paragraphs, headings or subheadings.	
I can discuss changes to my work with the teacher or my friends.	
I use expression when presenting or performing my work to the class.	
Spelling	
I can use the first two letters of a word to check spellings in the dictionary.	
I can spell words from the Year 3 Word List.	
I can spell homophones and near homophones.	
I can spell irregular past tense verbs e.g. hear / heard, think / thought.
