## Milk Spring Term 2024

**If you would like your child to have school milk in the Spring Term (8<sup>th</sup> Jan – 28<sup>st</sup> Mar 2024), please can you pay online at parentpay.com as soon as possible. The cost of milk is £19.35 per term.** If you have not already activated your ParentPay account, please look out for your activation email.

Some children will be eligible for free school milk. e.g. if your child is under 5 for the whole of the Spring Term 2024 or if your child is entitled to free school meals based on certain eligibility criteria. In this case please can you send an email request for free school milk in the Spring Term to <u>parents@deepdale.lancs.sch.uk</u> as soon as possible so that we can ensure your child does not miss out. Please state the name and class of your child in the email.

#### Free School Meals

Lancashire County Council have approved supermarket vouchers to be ordered for all eligible families this half term. If you have already registered you, do not need to register again. If you have not registered yet, and think, you might be eligible, please follow this link and apply.

You may be able to get the vouchers if you get any of the following: -

- Universal Credit with a household income of less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
- Income-Based Jobseekers' Allowance
- Income-Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit, not entitled to Working Tax Credit and household income less than £16,190
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Income Support
- Working Tax Credit 'run on' the payment you receive for a further four weeks after you finish work

A very important message for all parents. We will not authorise parents taking children out of school during term time for family holidays.


Any unauthorised leave during term time may risk families receiving a penalty notice or legal action being taken.

Should a penalty notice be issued, each parent will be fined a minimum of £60 or £120 depending on how soon payment is made.

If the fine is not paid, you may be required to attend Court and this could result in a fine for each parent of up to £1000 per child and a Criminal Record.
